Scaffolding Inspection

Introduction

The course aims to provide personnel concerned with scaffolding safety and approvals, an in depth understanding of the safety requirements for scaffolds generally, and in particular, the approvals processes to be applied to independent and special scaffolds used in the construction and maintenance of installations.

Target Audience

Scaffold Supervisors, Safety Officers and those personnel nominated or required to approve the use of scaffold structures.

Course Syllabus: Theory

This course consists of a series of theory presentations followed by practical demonstrations and candidate participation.

By the end of the program, participants will have the knowledge to identify, list, describe and/or demonstrate:

- An outline of the requirements for scaffolding including personal and worksite safety, protection of others;
- Identification of the common forms of scaffolds with emphasis on British Standard tube/coupling types, common fittings and accessories;
- Use, inspection and maintenance of safety equipment including full body harnesses with shock absorber lanyard, ropes, belts;
- Preparation, use, inspection and maintenance of scaffolding materials;
- Use, inspection and maintenance of ladders and gin wheels;
- Knowledge and practice of the criteria required for safety inspection of all types of scaffolding structures;
- An understanding of the planned work and hazards involved with the work;
- Recognition of the safety hazards for the types of scaffolds listed;
- A knowledge and practical application of general safety regulations;
- Inspection of scaffolds using the SCAFFTAG system

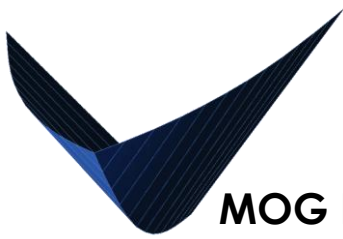
Competency
