- Understand the requirements of the applicable standards (EN, ISO, ASME etc.);
- Be able to ascertain if the rigging equipment meets the requirements set out in the standard and those of the manufacturer;
- To carry out inspections, maintenance and repairs in accordance with the standards;
- Prepare reports in accordance with LOLER '98 and client requirements.
