

About This Course

STCW Personal Survival Techniques (PST) is designed to form part of the minimum Basic Safety Training programme for seafarers and is a mandatory requirement for anyone who wishes to work at sea.

The aim of the course is to give all delegates a basic knowledge of the actions to be taken by individuals to protect themselves in emergency situations and includes practical training in the use of life jackets and inflatable life rafts. Exercises are carefully supervised by qualified staff and can be undertaken by non-swimmers.

The course includes:

- Main types of maritime emergencies
- Types of life-saving appliances and survival craft
- Equipment in survival craft
- Location of personal life-saving appliances
- Principles of survival during a maritime emergency
- Practical sea survival sessions in our purpose-built sea survival facility

The course is also included in our **STCW Basic Safety Training Week**.
